



Important Program Changes

For *Michigan & Indiana* Commercial & Industrial Customers

Beginning July 1, 2020, Indiana Michigan Power Commercial & Industrial Energy Efficiency Program's are implementing the following changes. Projects must be completed by the end of the year to take advantage.

- Removing incremental cost test screen from all application processes. Incentives are now capped at **75% of total or material cost**, depending on the project type.
- Increasing non-lighting incentive level from \$0.052 (MI)/\$0.060 (IN) to **\$.08 per kWh across both Indiana and Michigan territories.**
- Increasing the prescriptive pre-approval threshold from current \$5,000 to **\$10,000.**
- Raising the HP cap on prescriptive VFDs (up to **100HP** on HVAC pumps and fans and up to **50HP** on process pumps and fans).

The previous bonus program will now end **July 1, 2020.**

Lighting Incentive Enhancements:

- Offering rebates similar to early 2019 levels on LED tubes, LED Exterior replacing HID, LED Interior replacing HID and LED Fixtures.
Popular lighting measures including LED 8' and 1000w HID to LED have been added to the Prescriptive Program. Check the measure list for full list of offerings.
- **Increasing Custom lighting incentive to \$.07/kWh from current levels.**
