



### Property Owner Authorization

This Agreement is made by and between Indiana Michigan Power Company ("I&M") and \_\_\_\_\_, ("Owner" or "Authorized Agent") of the premises located at: \_\_\_\_\_ on behalf of \_\_\_\_\_ ("Tenant") of the premises and Account holder with I&M.

I&M may provide energy efficiency services at the above-described premises through I&M's Weatherproofing Programs as follows:

- (a) Installation of energy efficient light bulbs, and if water heater is electric: energy efficient kitchen and bath aerators, shower heads, hand held shower head, and hot water pipe wrap;
- (b) Further measures may include insulation, and air sealing. Installation of measures is determined by the current needs of the home and the cost-effectiveness of the measures.

The Owner/Authorized Agent:

- Declares that they are the legal Owner/Authorized Agent of the property listed above
- Grants I&M and/or its authorized contractors permission to enter the premises to assess the potential for weatherization upgrades, evaluate the heating and cooling system(s) and current condition of insulation, and install energy efficiency measures as described above, at no additional cost to the Tenant or Owner for eligible **Income Qualified Weatherproofing tenants\*\***, as deemed appropriate by I&M's energy analysis. If Tenant is **non-Income Qualified**, the Owner/Authorized Agent grants permission for the check-up to be completed for a \$99 fee and consents to additional recommended measures to be installed. Payment of the co-pay and customer portion of the recommended improvements is determined between the Tenant and the Owner/Authorized Agent. This payment is due to the contractor performing the prescribed weatherization work.

\*\*If Tenant is **not** Income Qualified, the home checkup and installations listed in subsection (a) above remain the same in the regular Weatherproofing Program. I&M pays 50% of the recommended upgrades up to \$3000 listed in subsection (b) above, as compared to 100% of the recommended upgrades in the Income Qualified Weatherproofing program. The Weatherproofing program for non-Income Qualified tenant will include a \$99 fee that will go towards the recommended upgrades covered by the customer and paid to the contractor installing the air sealing and insulation. The Owner/Authorized Agent has the choice to have the recommended upgrades installed for each program.
