(Customer) contracts for and Indiana Michigan Power Company (Company) agrees to provide Demand Response Service – Capacity Performance Resource Product in accordance with the terms and conditions of Rider D.R.S.1, a copy of which is attached and made a part of this Contract.

Acknowledgement Regarding Capacity

Performance Non-Compliance Charge

(Customer to Initial _____)

The Customer understands that it is responsible for, and agrees to pay, all charges associated with its failure to comply with requested test or actual event curtailments. This requirement applies to all customers taking service under Rider D.R.S.1, including both those customers participating directly in Rider D.R.S.1 and those that do so through a Curtailment Service Provider (CSP). **These charges may exceed the sum of the customer's monthly Demand Credits for the delivery year, as stated under the Annual Non-Compliance Charge section of Rider D.R.S.1.** Specific customer non-compliance charge examples are available upon request.

Curtailed Demand

The customer's Curtailed Demand shall be determined based upon the method of measurement chosen by the customer. The method chosen shall remain in effect for the entire contract period. Both methods are subject to summer and winter seasonality. Summer is defined as June through October and the following May. Winter is defined as November through April. The customer shall choose from one of the following:

- 1) Firm Service Level (FSL) - Customer shall designate seasonal FSL in kW per account, which is the demand to which the customer agrees to reduce to or below during a test for each hour during a curtailment event. Payment for FSL shall be seasonal and loss-adjusted.
- 2) Guaranteed Load Drop (GLD) - Customer shall designate seasonal GLD in kW per account, which is the minimum demand reduction that the customer will provide for each hour during a curtailment event or during a curtailment test. Payment for GLD shall be seasonal and loss-adjusted.

Unless the Parties mutually agree otherwise, this Contract shall be in effect for an initial period of four (4) delivery years for new customers and shall remain in effect until either party provides three (3) years' written notice prior to March 1 of its intention to discontinue service under the terms of this Contract for the fourth delivery year beginning after the notice is provided. The first Delivery Year under this Contract is designated as June 1, 2026 to May 31, 2027.
